The information provided has been developed to guide all stakeholders to understand the policies, procedures, rules, and regulations. Parents are encouraged to check with their school to ensure their student(s) are appropriately tagged as bus riders before the first day of school.



## IN-ZONE ROUTES

Per policy, any elementary student who meets one of the following criteria will be picked up .2 of a mile from their place of residence:

- Students who live within the respective school zone
- Gifted routes: Woodvale Elementary
- ESL routes: Broadmoor Elementary, Carencro Bob Lilly Elementary, Katherine Drexel Elementary, S. J. Montgomery Elementary, Ridge Elementary, and Westside Elementary
- SPED students with IEP mandate

### Responsibility of the parents or appointed designee for both regular and special education students:

- 1 Have the child at the designated bus stop 10-15 minutes before the regularly scheduled time and provide the necessary supervision until the bus arrives.
- 2 Meet the bus upon its return to the designated bus stop before the scheduled arrival time or make appropriate provisions for the student's welfare when and if the student cannot be met at the designated bus stop.
- 3 PreK students must have someone at the bus stop every morning and afternoon. Failure to do so may result in loss of bus transportation privileges.

- SPED students with IEP mandate
