

LEVYING OF MILLAGES FOR THE YEAR 2024

Youngsville, LA – July 31, 2024- The Youngsville City Council will hold a public hearing and a public meeting on September 12, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. to hear public comments and adopt Resolutions to levy the millage rates for the year 2024.

Publications will appear in the official journal, The Daily Advertiser, as follows:

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Article 7, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B) that a public hearing of the City Council of the City of Youngsville in Lafayette Parish will be held at its regular meeting place in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 201 Iberia Street, Youngsville, LA 70592 on Thursday, September 12, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. to consider levying additional or increased millage rates without further voter approval or adopting the adjusted millage rates after reassessment and rolling forward to rates not to exceed the prior year's maximum. The estimated amount of tax revenues to be collected in the next year from increased millage is \$2,499,611, and the amount of increase in taxes attributable to the millage increase is \$159,145.
